MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

MEMBERSHIP INDEMNITY

- Membership and Advantage Card purchases are valid for the 2025 golf season only.
- Memberships and Advantage Cards are non-transferrable and do not confer any ownership or liability for the property or the assets of Stonebridge Golf Club.
- Members and Card holders acknowledge that the golf course is private property and purchasing a membership or Advantage Card does not in itself represent any right of entry onto the golf course. Members and Card holders agree to comply with all course restrictions and further agree to not walk, trespass, or play any portion of the golf course without first registering with the Pro Shop.
- Advance booking privileges: Member – 7 days, Card Holder – 6 days, Public – 5 days.
- **7 Day Memberships** - Unlimited personal golf 7 days a week excluding tournaments.
- **5 Day Memberships** - Unlimited personal golf Monday to Friday excluding holidays and tournaments. 5 Day members are also invited to play in Club Championship and Intersectional events at no additional charge. Any play outside these times the member may play for the posted Advantage Card Green Fee rate.
- **Couple Memberships** - A couple is two adults in a traditional marriage or alternative lifestyle living at the same residence. Proof of residency may be required.
- Members receive 15% off regular priced clothing in the Pro Shop.
- Guests of Members receive 10% off the regular posted Daily Green Fee.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- All persons using the facilities at Stonebridge Golf Club agree to always adhere to the standard Code of Conduct.
- Be respectful of all members, guests, and staff and do not interfere with staff who are performing their duties on property.
- Respect the privacy of homeowners and their property while playing the golf course or visiting Stonebridge.
- Do not enter onto a private residence for any reason and only interact with residents on private property should you accidentally damage their property with an errant golf shot. Members have window breakage insurance through their Golf Canada membership. Advantage Card players have the option to purchase a Golf Canada membership.
- Do not drive power carts on city streets for any reason other than crossing from one hole to another in designated road crossing areas.
- Failure to comply with the above will result in expulsion from Stonebridge or a suspension of playing privileges.

STONEBRIDGE RESIDENT

- Stonebridge Golf Club offers different rates to residents of the Stonebridge Community.
- Stonebridge Resident rates are only offered to those who reside in the Stonebridge Levy Affected Addresses as defined by the City of Ottawa. Proof of address is required by showing your property tax bill.

CANCELLATION

- Memberships and Advantage Cards are non-refundable after June 15, 2025. Requests before June 15, 2025 will be considered for medical reasons only and will be subject to an administrative fee of \$100 per person. Green Fees for played rounds will not be refunded in the membership price.

NO SHOW POLICY

- The credit card on this application may be charged for all no-shows when a member fails to provide a minimum of 24 hours cancellation notice for themselves and all guests.

DRESS CODE

LOCKERS

- Personal lockers are available to rent on a seasonal basis (\$50+tx/locker).
- Contents of lockers must be removed no later than October 31, 2025.

TOURNAMENT PLAY

- Stonebridge Golf Club will not provide compensation of any kind to members when tournament rounds interfere with playing privileges.

JUNIOR/BANTAM MEMBERSHIP RESTRICTIONS

- Junior & Bantam members are not permitted to play:
 1. Before 12:00pm on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays
 2. In Men's Night, Ladies Social Night, or Ladies League events
- Only Juniors who are at least 16 years of age and possess a valid driver's license may rent a power cart.

GOLF CANADA FEES

- Golf Canada Fees are mandatory for all members (encouraged, but optional for Advantage Card holders). This provides each member with a Golf Canada Membership, allowing access to the Golf Canada Score Centre where you can track stats, get an official Handicap Index, receive up to \$7,000 of incident protection, and take advantage of many other benefits. POWER CARTS

The person(s) (the “LESSEE”) signing below with respect to membership or Advantage Card for the 2025 also sign for any rental of a golf cart during the 2025 season agrees to abide by all rules and regulations as set by Stonebridge Golf Club (the “LESSOR”) from time to time, including, without limitation, the following:

- Only two persons and two golf bags allowed at any time. No towing permitted (eg. hand carts)
- No minors permitted to operate cart at any time.
- Emergency brake must be applied when parked.
- Keep both feet inside cart when moving.
- Be sure that the operator is sitting down and in full control of the cart and has checked directional switch or key position to ensure that it is in the proper position before releasing emergency brake or before touching throttle.
- Keep cart off greens and tees.

Furthermore, LESSEE acknowledges and agrees that:

- LESSEE shall hold LESSOR and its affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, employees, and agents, and any other parties for whom they are in law responsible, harmless from any damage or claims of any nature whatsoever that may arise from or through LESSEE's use of said golf cart. The receipt of said golf cart in good order and repair is hereby acknowledged by LESSEE.
- LESSEE represents that he or she is familiar with the operation and use of said golf cart and that he or she has read the instructions. LESSEE promises and agrees to pay for any damages that are sustained to said golf cart while same is in LESSEE's custody. LESSEE also agrees to be personally responsible for any bodily injury and/or property damage by reason of the use of said golf cart.
- Golf cart is hereby leased for not more than (9) or (18) holes at a time. The full agreement between the LESSOR and the LESSEE is contained herein, and time is of the essence.
- LESSOR has the right to take possession of cart without any refund of fee when any of the instructions above are violated.
- Trail Fees are offered to Adult and Intermediate members as well as Advantage Card holders of Stonebridge Golf Club only. This allows one member or card holder to one power cart seat anytime they play. Any other riders are required to pay their cart fee. Non-transferrable.
- Blue accessible flags are available for golfers who require one. This flag allows the rider access halfway to greens past the NO CARTS signage in the fairway. Carts must go backwards from this point and return to paths before the curbed area begins. This does not allow a cart to leave the path on par 3's at any time, nor does it allow carts to leave the path when the course is designated “Cart Path Only”.

Membership applications must be completed and submitted in full to be considered.

Stonebridge Golf Club reserves the right to set the annual fee and the right to revoke/suspend playing privileges and/or not to renew an application at any time.
